Here are a few ways to support the HSA with no additional cost to you:

Box Tops for Education: *make sure to clip your box top labels from General Mills products and send them into school with your child. So far this school year we raised \$744!*

Target's Take Charge of Education: *you can earn money for your schools each time you use your Target Red Card. Go to www.target.com and enroll today. (Go to rbhsa.net for directions)*

Wednesday is "Italia II Night": *every Wed. Italia II will donate 10% to the HSA of the first \$500 spent. Whether it's a delivery or pick up order just mention the RBHSA and sign the event form. Italia II will keep track and send a check at the end of each month. It's that easy! To date the HSA has received almost \$200 from Italia II!*

"Fridays are special II": *every Friday at Italia II from 6-8pm (dine in only) kids can eat for \$1 (slice or pasta with a drink) with the purchase of an adult meal. There will also be a clown there to entertain the kids while you eat! Italia II will give \$1 back for each kids meal.*
